


Crossword Puzzle

- To remove flaws from or to perfect or complete.
- The reference points that are set in the file to allow easy access to specific parts.

- Going back over a written document to look for errors and correct them.
- The act of recording sound digitally. A discrete point in time that a sound signal is divided into when digitizing.
- When two or more separate files are combined to create one new file.

- The clearness of thought or style.
- The unit of measurement for frequency or cycles per second.
- When the sound being recorded goes above the maximum allowed, the sound is distorted.
